Job Fair Co-Sponsor:

October 19, 2016; February 14, 2017

WYSU-FM co-sponsored job fairs with YSU Career Services on October 19, 2016 & February 14, 2017. Career & Counseling Services represents 15,029 YSU students, and many women & minority students participate in the Job Fair. YSU is an Affirmative Action/Equal Opportunity employer committed to increasing the diversity of its faculty, staff, and students. Career Services is committed to helping all students find rewarding employment. The Fall 2016 job fair had 92 employers from the region in attendance with 335 students attending; while the Spring 17 fair had 93 employers from the area and 292 students in attendance.

Internship Programs:

WYSU-FM offers paid student employee opportunities for Youngstown State University students in the areas of: engineering, programming, development, web design, business administration, and cataloging. During this reporting period, 7 students were employed.

Scholarship Programs:

WYSU-FM sponsors, and is responsible for the funding for, two minority broadcast/journalism scholarships. The WYSU-FM Broadcasting Scholarship helps to develop the next generation of broadcasters. A scholarship is awarded each year. Applicants for this scholarship must be a full time, traditional or non-traditional minority student, majoring in Telecommunications, with a minimum GPA of 2.7. This is an endowed scholarship, with a beginning endowment of \$10,000, managed by the Youngstown State University Foundation. WYSU-FM also established the Robert W. Peterson Scholarship and awards one scholarship each year to a second year minority student in English, Journalism, or Communications. It is also managed by the Youngstown State University Foundation.
